

# CFCH – Supply container to Hope Home



Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, for over 20 years CFCH has provided special assistance to the residents of Hope Home, FCH's residence for people with disabilities.

Due to covid restrictions and ongoing violence in Haiti, CFCH volunteers have been unable to work at Hope Home for the past 18 months. In addition to being unable to support the residents and House Mom's, this has also disrupted the regular delivery of supplies to Hope Home, which CFCH volunteers took with them on each trip.

A small shipment was arranged by air last December, but we still had an inventory of items in storage.

***We are therefore very grateful to the Compassionate Resource Warehouse in Victoria who arranged for us to use part of a container that another group is sending to Haiti.***

***We are also grateful to many supporters who donated additional items or provided funds to purchase some much-needed supplies.***

Items being shipped include two wheelchairs, personal care items for residents, gift boxes for House Moms, clothes, towels, sheets, medical supplies, PPE masks, supplies for the sensory tent... hundreds of necessary items that will enhance the lives of those at Hope Home.

We were also able to include tarps for the earthquake relief project, using these to line the bottom and top of each box and as padding between boxes to keep them in place.

As Gladys has reported in previous updates, basic day-to-day necessities are in very short supply in Haiti, and when they are available the cost is prohibitive – even more so after the earthquake.

At this very difficult time in Haiti, this shipment will be a huge blessing to the residents and staff at Hope Home.
