Yesterday morning went from great to amazing - one container finally arrived in Ghana, and then two YFC containers

were approved for funding. God is good!

The container for Ghana was packed in December and experienced delays in actually arriving. It is going to an organization called Bearing Fruits, and I have spent much time praying alongside these folks for it to arrive, so they were thrilled with the news! We believe that the Lord has a purpose for it arriving so late, and know that post-pandemic it will be such a huge help to those struggling in the remote communities they serve. When I talked with Shedrack he said that more people are dying of starvation than of Covid 19. It is so incredibly sad that this is the situation in many developing

countries now. Please pray that the container would clear customs quickly and without any issues in these next few days.

Belarus and YFC Burundi, who had applied for funds for a container. To receive the news of their approval was incredible! At 10:30 last night, I grabbed a quick Whatsapp call with Euphrate, the National Director for YFC Burundi, which was the start of the next day for him. My excitement doesn't compare to how thrilled and thankful him and his staff were for the news. They just received land from the government to build another school, and this container will go a long way to helping towards equipping this and their other schools, as well as their orphanage. Burundi is the 3rd poorest country in the world, so supplies like this will be so needed and treasured. As I thought about it, I was trying to put this in perspective. **Think about when you were a child and got something that you really, really wanted.** Think about how you guarded and protected it, and how much joy it brought you. Every item in the container will be valued just like this, and I believe even more so. Something like a doll for a child who has never had one before, or a pair of shoes for a teen who walks a long distance to get water, or a student who now has a pencil and notebook to use, or a sewing machine for someone to start earning a living for their family. So many things that we shared will be so highly treasured. We are thankful to the Lord for His provision in this way. Thank you for praying!!!
